ORIENTEERING 27 JUNE - 1 JULY 2021



27 June with start from 3pm in the afternoon, so you have more time to get here in time for the race. More news, we will use EMIT EKT punching system this summer.

Outside the competing, there is much else to see and do in both Idre Fjäll and nearby areas. We will tell you more about this in this invitation and give you a little taste of what the surroundings can offer.

There are different options of accommodation at Idre Fjäll and you can read more of those in the invitation (Bulletin).

Because of the Corona pandemic we are following the current situation very close. We are ready to adapt our event if required but we have hopes to be able to realize it as good and safe as possible.

COMPETITIONS

The Idre Fjäll week consists of five competitions which take place over five days. You register for each of these five competitions in Swedish Eventor.

There are "open" classes each day for those who want to register for the day. Remember, however, that it is cheaper to register in advance, even to the open classes.

CLASSES

Competition classes from 10-80 years + String courses. Children care is also available.

INFOCENTER

Event centre is located very close to the reception at Idre Fjäll. Here you can find all information given by our staff. It will be open from Saturday 26 June 2021. You can register to Open courses, pick up your Emit-card.

ACCOMODATION

Idre Fjäll is a year-round resort with a lot of options for your stay. You make your reservation at www.idrefjall.se.

TRAVEL

Idre Fjäll is located in the North-West part of the county of Dalarna, close to the Norwegian boarder.

Stockholm-Arlanda is about five hours drive from Idre Fjäll. From Oslo-Gardermoen is it approx. 4,5 hours drive.

DAY-1 MIDDLE - ARENA NIPFJÄLLET

Idre Fjäll Week 2020 begins with a challenging middle distance with Moderate topography. Both the runnability and visibility is very good. Some of the competition area is in bare mountain terrain, but there is also a guite detailed slope to handle.

DAY-2 LONG – ARENA NIPFJÄLLET

The second day of Idre Fjäll Week 2020 we offer a long-distance race in a bare mountain area. The whole area is a open land so the visibility is excellent. The runnability is also very good. The topography is hilly, from moderate to steep. If the weather is sunny and nice you will have extraordinary views during your race.

DAY-3 SPRINT – ARENA IDRE FJÄLL

ay 3 of Idre Fjäll Week we have a sprint. It will be held inside the Idre Fjäll Resort. Here you find a lot of cottages, smaller roads and paths but also ski slopes and ski lifts. The topography is quite hilly.

DAY-4 LONG - ARENA NORTH

For the second last day of Idre Fjäll Week 2020 we offer all the participants a quite small area but a very interesting one. Many smaller and bigger ridges surrounding the small creek Brunnan. Runnability and visibility is good, and the topography is moderate with some marshes.

DAY-5. MIDDLE – ARENA ASKEBYN

For the last day we are offering wonderful terrain with good runnability and visibility. Moderate topography and less details compared with other days.

In all areas used for the Idre Fjäll Week 2020 there are mainly coniferous forests. Almost no green areas and no clean-cut areas at all.

PUNCHING SYSTEM - EMIT EKT

Idrefjäll Week 2021 will use the punching system EMIT EKT. If you already have an EMIT EKT tag, you can use this if it is not older than 5 years. For those who do not have their own EKT Tag, we will offer these free of charge to borrow for the competition days during Idrefjäll Week 2021.

Please note that we use the EMIT EKT runner tag (the one with the backup patch) and NOT the EmiTTag (touchfree).

More info about EMIT and how it works will be presented in the PM.

ENTRIES

You may entry to Idre Fjäll Week 2021 via Swedish Eventor at the latest Sunday 20 June 2021, 23.59 PM.

SHOWERS / CHANGING ROOMS

There are no showers at the arenas (except Day 3), we refer to the facilities at Idre Fjäll and at your own stay.

NATURPASSET

"Naturpasset" is available immediately after the Idrefjäll week for those who want to come back later in the summer or autumn to enjoy the orientation terrain at Idre Fjäll.

The flags for the "Naturpasset" are available until the snow arrives.

"Naturpasset" consists of a "package" with a map of orientation checks. The controls can be visited at any time and any order and you can choose to walk, run and sometimes cycle to the controls.

STRING COURSE

We offer a String course for children all competition days which is free of charge. No pre-entry is needed.

WORLD CUP IDRE FJÄLL 2021

Idre Fjäll will host the Orienteering World Cup. It is the second round of the 2021 season, the days are 12-15 August 2021. Read more about World Cup Idre Fjäll at www.owc2021.se

In connection with the World Cup Idre Fjäll, three open races will be held for everyone to attend. These competitions are organized together with the clubs Särna SK and SK Smalspåret.

TRAINING AT IDRE FJÄLL


